Interventions During Pre-sedation



Interventions **Events Addressed by Supplemental oxygen (facemask, NC, blowby) During Presedation**
(Check all that apply)**Airway/Breathing**

- Apnea
- Airway obstruction, complete
- Airway obstruction, partial (Incl. stridor, snoring)
- Laryngospasm
- Coughing
- Excessive secretions
- Hypoxia
- Wheezing/bronchospasm
- Clinical/radiologic suspicion for pulmonary aspiration

Circulation

- Cardiac arrest
- Bradycardia
- Hypotension
- Hypertension

Neuro/Behavioral

- Inadequate depth of sedation
- Agitation/delirium (non-paradoxical)
- Paradoxical response to sedation
- Myoclonus or muscle rigidity
- Seizure

Other

- Death
- Hypothermia
- Vomiting
- Allergic reaction, anaphylaxis
- Allergic reaction, non-anaphylaxis
- Prolonged/longer-than-anticipated duration of recovery
